RAKAHURI WINTER TOURNAMENT

Your son / daughter is representing Ashgrove School at the Year 5/6 & 7/8 Rakahuri Primary Schools Winter Tournament. This year we have 8 Netball teams, 8 Football teams, 6 Hockey teams and 2 Rugby teams entered in the Winter Tournament. We require some extra parents / caregivers to manage some of the teams in each of the respective sports. On this day our 14 Table Tennis teams and 12 Bowls teams will be having their own tournament here at Ashgrove.

At the end of the event (approximately 2.45pm), **the children will be transported back to Ashgrove.**

Please ensure that your child has suitable warm clothing, hats etc. Students will play in their sports uniform but may wear warm tracksuits over top. Students going to winter tournament will need a packed lunch on the day and please ensure they have extra snacks / water for the tournament. If your child requires medication (asthma etc) please make sure they take it with them to winter tournament.
