Dear Parents/Caregivers,

North Canterbury Friday Sport Competition

This year our Year 5-8 students have the option of competing in the North Canterbury Friday Sport Competition. The sports include football, rugby, netball, hockey, bowls and table tennis. These competitions are graded according to the skill and ability of the teams.

If your child **does not** want to participate in the competitive competition, they will take part in a variety of non-competitive sporting activities at school.

The weekly Interschool Sports competition will run for 9 weeks in Term 2 & 3 beginning Friday 24th May. On Tuesday 2nd July students will compete in the full day Rakahuri Winter Tournament. Every Friday, weather permitting, competing students will have an early lunch and travel to the venues for a 1.30pm start to all games. Games are scheduled to finish at 2.30pm. The students will be leaving the parks at 2.45pm to arrive back at school at approximately 2.55pm.

If your child would like to take part in the competitive North Canterbury Friday Sport Competition please indicate on the form below and return to your child's homeroom teacher. To cover transport, equipment and uniform costs for the 10 competition days, we are asking for a contribution of \$36 per child. This is now live on Kindo and will remain open until **Friday 12th April**. All receipts for the contributions will be given after the competition starts. If you would like to discuss a payment plan for this, please contact the office.

Please note, all contributions are requested by this date to ensure our participation in the competition can go ahead. Should there not be sufficient contributions, the competition will not be viable to enter and we will not take part and parents will be refunded their contribution. Thank you in advance for your support.

Mahuri and Tūrepo teachers are acting as coaches and managers and I thank them for that. We will require parents as coaches and managers for our Netball, Hockey, Indoor Bowls, Table Tennis, Football and Rugby teams. Remember you don't need to be an expert on the sport and don't have to be available for every game during the season.
