## Koru Games

The Koru Games is a multi-day, multi-sport tournament hosted in Selwyn District for South Island Year 7 & 8 children from Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> September - Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> September.

We are offering this tournament as an **optional** activity. Students who do not wish to take part in the 3 day sporting event will be part of an alternative programme at school in The Arts, Technology, Science and / or Digital Technology.

If your child would like to participate in the 3 day event, a \$19.50 per child entry fee is required and is now payable via Kindo. **This payment will need to be made by Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> August (NO LATE PAYMENT, NO EXCEPTIONS).**

This three day tournament will provide participants with the chance to further their sporting endeavours within a competitive yet 'Fair Play' conscious environment. The sports to be included in 2019 are Basketball, Football, Hockey, Lawn Bowls, Netball, Rugby Sevens, Squash, Table Tennis, Tennis, Touch Ultimate Frisbee and Volleyball. Details for each sport are on the back of this notice. All sports will be hosted at Selwyn District venues. Our entries are dependent on numbers for each sport.

**Sport Specific Information**

**Basketball**

**Venue – Lincoln University Rec Centre.** The basketball competition will consist of separate boys and girls competitions playing 3-ball, three on three, half-court basketball. Each squad can have a maximum of five members.

**Football**

**Venue – Prebbleton Domain.** The football competition will consist of separate boys and girls competitions playing nine a side football. Each squad can have a maximum of 12 members.

**Hockey (fives)**

**Venue – Foster Park Hockey Turf, Goulds Road, Rolleston.** The hockey competition will consist of a mixed competition only, capped at 12 teams, playing five-a-side hockey (fives). Each squad can have a maximum of 8 members, and at least two players of each gender must be on the turf at all times.

**Lawn Bowls**

**Venues – Lincoln Bowling Club (adjacent to Netball & Rugby Sevens).** The lawn bowls competition will consist of separate boys (full), girls and mixed competitions, playing pairs bowls on an artificial green. Each squad will consist of two members.

**Netball**

**Venue – Selwyn Netball Centre (adjacent to Lawn Bowls & Rugby Sevens).** The netball competition will consist of a girls competition only playing seven a side netball. Boys are permitted to play within a girls team, provided there is no more than one boy in each of the circle or midcourt positions at any one time. Each squad can have a maximum of 10 members.

**Rugby Sevens**

**Venue – Lincoln Rugby Football Club (adjacent to Lawn Bowls & Netball)**

The rugby sevens competition will consist of separate boys and girls competitions, playing seven a side rugby sevens. Girls are permitted to play within a boys team. Each squad can have a maximum of 12 members.

**Squash**

**Venue – Lincoln University Rec. Centre Courts.** The squash competition will consist of separate boys and girls competitions, capped at 6 boys (full) and 6 girls teams, playing singles squash, point a rally scoring to 40 points or 15 minutes (whichever comes first). Each squad can have a maximum of three members, two playing in each match.

**Table Tennis**

**Venue – Rolleston Community Centre.** The table tennis competition will consist of separate boys (Full), girls and mixed competitions, playing matches consisting of one doubles and two singles games. Each squad can have a maximum of four members.

**Tennis**

**Venue – Prebbleton Tennis Club, Prebbleton Reserve.** The tennis competition will consist of separate boy (full)s, girls (full) and mixed competitions, playing doubles only. Each squad will consist of two members.

**Touch**

**Venue – Rolleston Rugby Club, Rolleston Reserve.** The touch competition will consist of separate boys, girls and mixed competitions playing six a side touch. Each squad can have a maximum of 14 members.

**Ultimate (frisbee)**

**Venue – Foster Park, beside hockey turf, Goulds Road, Rolleston.** The ultimate competition will consist of a mixed competition only, capped at 16 teams, playing 5-a-side ultimate. Each squad can have a maximum of 10 members and must be made up of an equal gender split. A full tournament will result in 9 games for each mixed team.

**Volleyball**

**Venue – Lincoln University Fields.** The volleyball competition will consist of separate boys and girls competitions playing four a side, outdoor volleyball. Each squad can have a maximum of six members
