## **Growing Together for Success**

Greetings Ashgrove whānau,

I hope this newsletter finds you well. As we navigate through another fantastic term filled with learning and growth, I want to take a moment to address an issue that is paramount to the safety of our tamariki: road safety.

It is crucial that we all play a part in ensuring our children understand the importance of road safety and are equipped with the knowledge and skills to navigate our streets safely. With this in mind, I urge you to reinforce the following road safety tips with your children:

- 1. **Stop, Look, Listen, Think**: Teach our tamariki the fundamental steps of crossing the road safely. Encourage them to stop at the curb, look both ways for approaching vehicles, listen for any oncoming traffic, and think carefully before crossing.
- 2. **Always Use the School Crossing**: Emphasize the importance of using designated crosswalks and pedestrian crossings when available. Remind them to wait for the signal to cross and to never dart out into the street unexpectedly.
- 3. **Hold Hands**: For younger children, stress the importance of holding an adult's hand when crossing the road. This provides an added layer of safety and helps prevent accidents.
- 4. **Be Alert**: Remind our tamariki to stay off their phones and avoid distractions when walking near roadways. Being alert and aware of their surroundings is key to staying safe.
- 5. **Set a Good Example**: As adults, we serve as role models for our children. Let's demonstrate responsible road behaviour by following traffic laws ourselves and always prioritizing safety.
- 6. A friendly reminder, please **Do Not Park in the Disability Carpark** unless you have a disability sticker.

It's imperative that we have these conversations with our children regularly and reinforce these practices both at home and at school. By working together as a community, we can create a safer environment for all our tamariki.

Thank you for your continued support in keeping our children safe.

#### SIGNING IN AND OUT OF STUDENTS & VISITORS / PARENTS / CAREGIVERS TO THE SCHOOL

- 1. When a student arrives late to school for any reason, they must go to the office and sign-in on the tablet.
- 2. When an adult visits the school for any reason, they must also sign in using the tablet to record their time in and record the time out when they leave.
- 3. If you are collecting your student due to illness, an appointment, or need to take them home early, the student must be signed out in the tablet by their caregiver/parent and ensure that the teacher knows you have picked them up.

Whenever possible, please advise your child's teacher and the school office in advance of pick up.

This system is for your child's safety and ensures we know where all students are at all times. It is also part of the safety procedures required for fire drills or lockdowns.

If you are picking your children up from school or have given permission for someone else to collect them, you / they will need to come into the school to collect them.

### DROP OFF ZONE


The main purpose is for buses transporting children. The drop off can be used by parents to drop off those students who can <u>independently</u> get out of the car and off to school. If your child needs assistance; i.e. needs door opened and backpack put on, your child is <u>not</u> ready for this drop off zone.

This is not a parking area

- Entry to the drop off area will be from West Belt end and exited from the Kinley Street end. Arrows indicate the direction of traffic.
- A little rule to always remember Drive Left in Drive Left out.
- Drivers <u>must not</u> leave their vehicles and <u>must</u> park in the designated drop off zone
- Please move as far forward as you can to allow other vehicles to have access
- Children must leave the vehicle from the passenger side of the car onto the walk way not onto the road

Drivers will need to be courteous when entering and leaving the area taking extreme care watching for foot traffic.

PLEASE NOTE: The drop off zone is not a thoroughfare into the school for pedestrians. The Drop off closes at 8.50am in time for learning.
