

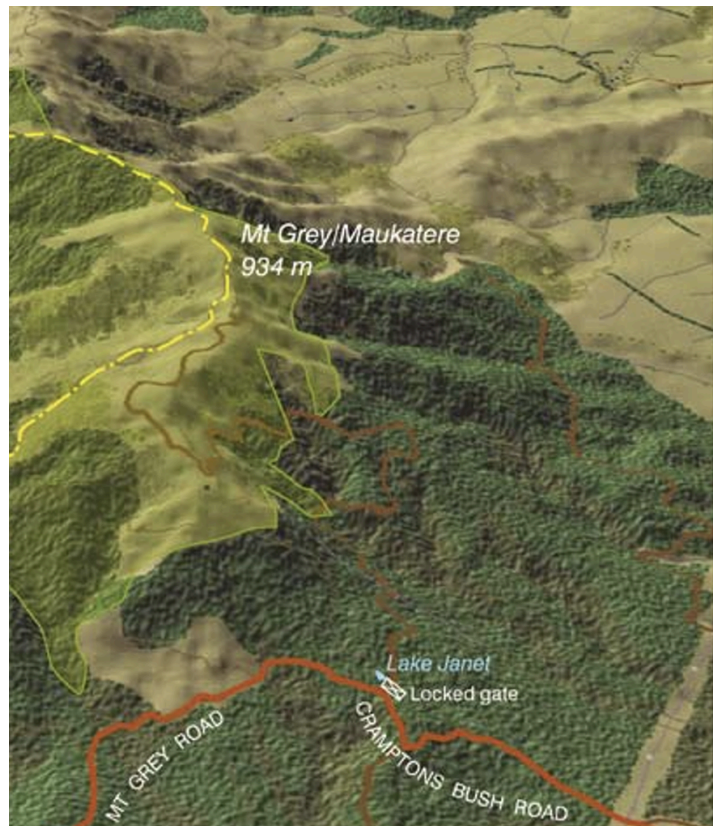

We will leave school at 9am and return to school by approximately 3.00pm. We will require parents to provide transport to and from the Lake Janet Picnic Area and to actively supervise and hike with us during the day.
